


# What is an autism spectrum disorder?

An ASD is something you are born with and you have for your whole life.






People with an ASD look the same as other people.




People with an ASD find some things hard. They might find it hard to

- understand what other people are saying.


- look at other people's eyes when talking to them.




People with an ASD might also find it hard to




- share things.



- take turns.






- make friends.

People with ASD might not like






- loud noises, like fireworks.
